- Camps are non-refundable. In the case of an emergency a student can switch to a different camp or alternate week. Production camps are a full two week commitment with a public performance on the evening of the last day of camp. Please make sure campers are available for the entire time. Phones will be asked to be put away during class.
- Student should refrain from bringing toys, distracting items, or valuables to camp.
- Students should dress comfortably with close-toed shoes. Keep in mind, camp can get messy.
- A supervised lunch will be held for those that are involved in full day camps or taking two half days camps.
- Students should also bring snacks and water bottles or drinks for breaks. Students should bring a bag lunch.
- On the last day of camp, there will be a 10-15 minute showcase for students to share their experiences and whats they learned with their parents.
- A LIMITED number of pertain or full scholarships based on financial needs are available. Scholarship forms are available on our website.
- Parents or other adults are not allowed in the classroom.
- An adult must sign any student under the age of 16 in and out each day.
- If a single student signs up for more than two camps, or if there are multiple students from the same household signing up, please contact The Prizery for discounted rates. Payment plans can be set up with The Prizery.
- A minimum number of 10 students is required for a camp to be held. Any camp canceled by The Prizery will be refunded to all student registered.
