

Stained Glass Stepping Stones



September: 18th and 19th 6-8pm

You will learn how to use stained glass to create a beautiful mosaic-style garden stone. The two session class will involve discussions about glass selection and provide instruction on adhering glass to the stone. Participants will learn how to grout the stone and then how to preserve the stone. During the 2nd session, participants will get a demonstration on glass cutting and will be offered an opportunity to practice hands-on.

All materials are included in the price, including precut stained glass pieces and grout.

No tools required, however, participants should bring:

- a pair of dishwashing/latex gloves (to protect hands from the grout),
- a face mask to be used when mixing the small batch of grout, and
- safety glasses if they wish to practice glass cutting.
